

UNIFORM POLICIES

Providence requires all students to wear a uniform. Details on the uniform policy are provided below.

MODESTY: The principles that guide our dress code are those of modesty, decorum, respect, and consideration for others. Students should dress with those principles in mind. Modest clothing does not draw attention to one's self; it glorifies God by reflecting truth, beauty, and goodness. A good rule of thumb is that our dress ought to always draw a person's eye to our face not to any other part of our body. Christians should be concerned more for their neighbor than they are for themselves. They should dress in a way that shows respect and consideration for the people they are around.

GRAMMAR STUDENTS UNIFORM & GROOMING POLICY

General: All clothing worn by students at the school or at school-sponsored functions must be neat, clean, and pressed as required. Student must be clean and neatly groomed. At all times, the students will present a modest appearance that does not call undue attention to their physical appearance. The headmaster or his designee shall be the final arbiter as to whether or not any particular student meets the requirements and spirit of this policy.

The school uniform may be purchased at Famously Yours or may be the *French Toast brand name (unless otherwise stated)*. Famously Yours is located at 9981 Lin Ferry, St. Louis, MO 63123 (just off Lindbergh Blvd., across from the Tesson Ferry Library). Their web sight is famouslyyours.com. Famously Yours offers better quality items. French Toast items are available on-line, by phone order, or from select stores (Sears, Target, Burlington Coat Factory, Kids 'R Us, Catholic Supply). **All students must have a dress uniform.** Other uniform choices listed are purely optional at the discretion of individual families.

HAIR:

Boys: Hair must be clean, neatly groomed, and a natural color. The hair should not extend below the bottom of the shirt collar. Hairstyles must not cause undue attention to the student (for example, skinhead and mohawk hairstyles are not allowed).

Girls: Hair must be neatly groomed and a natural color. Hairstyles must not cause undue attention to the student.

JEWELRY (BOYS & GIRLS)

The wearing of jewelry or other ornamentation (including those worn in the hair) should be discrete, tasteful, and not cause undue attention to the student. Boys may not wear earrings.
